I have an overdue account?

## **Surprise** could look like:

- Your account is overdue
- Your computer has a virus

## **Control** could look like:

- Act now or miss out
- Pay direct, bypass systems

## **Access** could look like:

- Verify account by logging in
- Give us remote access

## **Money** could look like:

- Pay a 'processing' fee for prize
- Send giftcards to help online friend

## If you've already paid money:

- Contact your bank immediately.
- Reach out to your family/whānau for support.
- Contact Netsafe for advice about next steps.
